A good example was the Snooker layout where the competitor had to pot red, colour, red, as in the real game and then clear up the colours in the correct order. If there was seven ways of cocking this up – Dave found the eighth!

As always Dave did well in the simple speed stages, with Pete doing better in the complicated ones. Jim was over the moon with his Mover stage and may have come 3rd in this. It really was a layback relaxing shoot with plenty of tea and buns between stages.

Jason had entered with his under-lever and as he was on his own, he was really taken by the variety of shooting on offer it is not certain how well he did. He was also keen to try his 44 LBR and had entered not knowing what to expect



Jim agreed to enter under-lever on the day and went round the same course with him in the afternoon. Jim finished half way while Jason picked up a prize.



Jason also entered the shotgun event with his 20 bore garden gun, and found the large heavy plates difficult to knock down. Once he worked it out, he was placed in his class and collected another prize.
