



# Event report

Steel Plate Challenge, Twyford, 13 Feb 2011

## **NIGEL AND ROB ARE THE MOST ACCURATE AND THE QUICKEST**

**The Challenge was well supported this year with twenty people having a go.**

The Challenge is to knock down twelve steel plates, the first six being quite large but the last six diminishing in size, in the shortest time.



It was shot both supported (elbows on the firing point) and unsupported.

With the only clear round, Nigel took top position in the Unsupported, much to the chagrin of Competition Officer Keith because Nigel used Keith's rifle!

It was suggested to all competitors that they put two rounds in one magazine and ten in the other. If they started with the two rounds they could fire one shot then do a mag change to save time on pulling the bolt back.

We therefore had:

- Those who fired two rounds then changed magazines and still had to pull the bolt back.
- One, who fired one round, changed the magazine and then pulled the bolt back so he ejected a live round and so he only had eleven rounds to fire at the plates.
- One whose name will be withheld but he was the last to shoot (Dave) who loaded with ten rounds, fired one shot, took the mag out, put the two round mag in, fired two shots plus two dry before he put the other eight rounds back in.

Mention should be made of Bob G who appears from the scores to have been accurate but slow. This was because he used a bolt action CZ rifle and still managed to score better than some.

Marianne could have won the aggregate prize – if there had been one!

Tim and Bryan managed to splatter the range with lead using the long barrel pistols – lots of noise but not too many hits although to be fair their supported was just leaning the shoulder against the wall.
