The Fly Shoot for year 2015 was held on Sunday 17 January 2016 to try to fit it in before the AGM.



Weather conditions? An inch or so of snow, temperatures at zero but a bonus that the wind was virtually nil.

Was it so cold and snowy that nobody turned up? No, twenty one shooters turned out for this comp, well there were twenty one targets handed in and nobody was seen to sneak off without showing theirs!

Various rifles and various calibres were used, including Siobhan with her single shot Rossi and Gavin who used a single shot BSA Martini .22 rimfire, to shoot two sighters and ten to count at the Flies.

Scoring is one point a hit on a wing or leg, two points for a hit on the head or body. The Flies are 0.905" / 23mm wide by 1.1" / 28mm high so the rifle has to be capable of half inch groups at 100m. The shooter has to be capable of this as well!

It's not an easy shoot on a nice warm day but in freezing temperatures in the snow it's doubly difficult as some of the scores show.

Once again the Club tradition has been upheld as the winner Linsey not only beat the James with his own rifle she but won the comp as well. Our commiserations to James.
