A nice simple competition for the first of the season, ten chickens on an A4 sheet of paper, one shot at each chicken standing unsupported. The chickens are scaled down from the normal metal silhouettes for 25m.

If a shot clips the chicken it counts as a hit, but as a number of shooters got the same score I had to break the tie by counting the number of shots that were completely inside the chicken to give the final placings.

Nineteen people handed in targets for scoring but if anyone took theirs away and it scored eight they would have won 😞
