ARMY TARGET SHOOTING CLUB OPEN COMPETITION.

9/10 April



Three Club members who are also members of the ATSC at Bisley went to help run their Open event. This is a combination of ISSF pistol and black powder pistol shooting and Gallery Rifle.

Dave, Jim and Phil had the opportunity to shoot the day before they were working as Range officers and had some successes and failures.

25m Precision

Jim had never shot precision with his LBR before and did OK, coming second. He missed winning by just one point.

Timed and Precision 1 SB

This went OK too for Jim, 298 SB gave him 5th place. Phil was suffering with unreliability and clearing jams so only managed a 293.

Timed and Precision 1 CF

300/22 gave Jim a 3rd place in X class but Dave was having problems and racked a round out in the quick stage scoring 290/22

Phil was 3rd in A class with 299/20 but annoyed knowing he should have done better.

Timed & Precision 1 LBR

A disappointing 291 placed Jim 2nd in A class.

Multi-Target SB and CF

Nobody from Derby did well in either of these events and should practice more!

Multi-Target LBR

Not a great score but a 107 for Jim won B class.

Aggregate of Precision/T&P1/MT

To his surprise Jim won the Tankard for the total score of the three events.

America Match

This event includes slow fire at 50m and timed at 25m. Phil had not shot this before and it went OK, with him finishing about half way in SB & CF.

1500 SB

Jim's 1470 should have been better but for a few silly wild shots.

Dave was suffering with his knee injury and had to go standing for those stages.



Meanwhile Phil's rifle was still playing up and really he struggled.

1500 CF

A flock of 9's at the first 50m stage put paid to any hope of a good score from Jim.

But Phil did well and shot 1466 to win A class.

Summary

It was a good test of equipment and its operators and a few medals were collected. More importantly the Derby Members helped to run another successful competition.
