.22 25m Benchrest

This competition is shot for highest score on the UK22BR target which has 25 scoring targets each with a highest score of 10 plus an X ring.

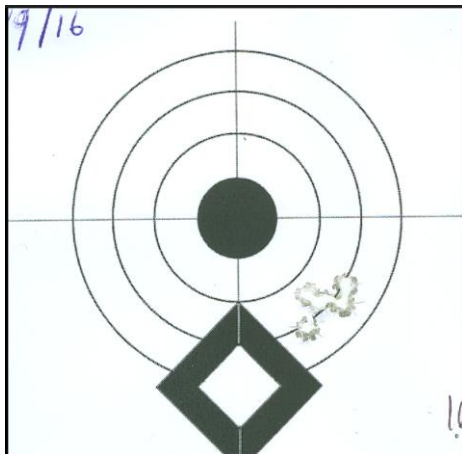

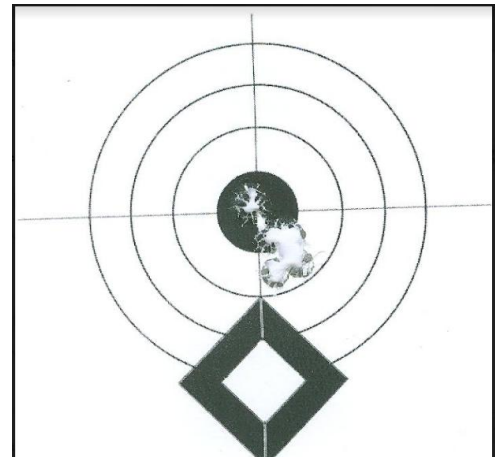
