In A class Jim St did well with 114.

While in B class Simon B won with a 110, Keith M was 8<sup>th</sup>.

## Multi-Target LBP

Phil managed to keep his gun going despite problems and 1451 placed him 7<sup>th</sup> in A class.

Jim Sm was 4<sup>th</sup> in A class with 1478.

Our highest scorer was Tim M with 1482 which meant he won B class.

Phil was 3<sup>rd</sup> in C class.

**1500 LBP**

Tim M shot a 1438 for 8<sup>th</sup> place in A class.
