Timed & Precision 1 SB

Meanwhile in A class the competition was just a fierce but Phil won with a PB maximum 300/10 and getting him promoted into X class next time.

There were five Team Derby shooters battling it out in B class. Ian took first place with 293/13 with Simon in second place.

Timed & Precision 1 CF
