Timed & Precision 1 SB

Timed & Precision 1 CF

Phil beat Jim with 300/16 because a round did not feed properly and in the rush put a big fat 9 on the target.

Timed & Precision 1 LBR

In A class Jim shot a PB 297 to be outright winner, beating those in X class.

Multi-Target SB

Neither were happy with their scores but Jim came 2nd and Phil 3rd.

Multi-Target CF

Jim won X class with 118 and a lot of x's, but Phil had a late shot and still came 6th.

Multi-Target LBR

Newly promoted into X class Jim was 2nd with 108.

1500 SB



Jim made a mess of M4 and was disappointed with 1462. While in A class it was very close and Phil won on x count with a much better score than Jim, so he keeps reminding him.

1500 CF

Jim was reasonably happy with his until the last 50m stage where to daft 8's made it a 1486. Not so good for Phil in B class, 5th with 1460.

1020 SB



Phil tried this for the first time – It is a shortened version of the 1500 match and without the 50m stage. Not bad, a 999 for 2nd place.

Advancing Target SB

Phil enjoyed this, winning A class with 261, only a few points behind the X class winner.

Advancing Target CF

Jim thought he was on for a good score until he fired coming into aim scoring a 2! Still the rest went OK and he won X class.

Phil won B class with a 172.

Advancing Target LBR

It was the first time Jim had shot this event and it took a couple of runs to work out a way of doing it. He cleaned the last two runs and was outright winner!
