SILHOUETTE COMPETITION

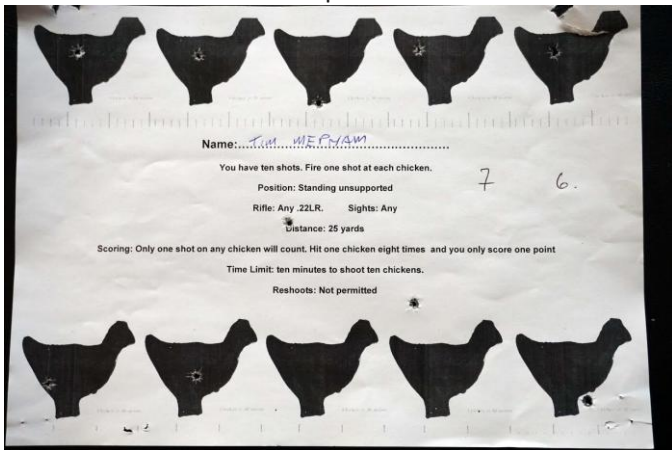
8 & 11 January

This competition was run over two Club sessions.

Usually the Competition Officer holds comps on just the Sunday session but for some inexplicable reason he had a brain storm (or was it melt down?) and decided to extend it to the following Wednesday as well.

The competition is quite straight forward, ten shots at ten chicken shapes, fired in ten minutes but for some reason shooting at an irregular shape target puts shooters off. Those who normally score well on a conventional round target never do as well on the chickens.

There were twenty targets handed in for scoring with none seen in the bin so plenty of entries. Scoring is one point per hit on the chicken, an edge clip still counting as a hit. To sort out tie scores hits that are wholly in the chicken are then counted up.
